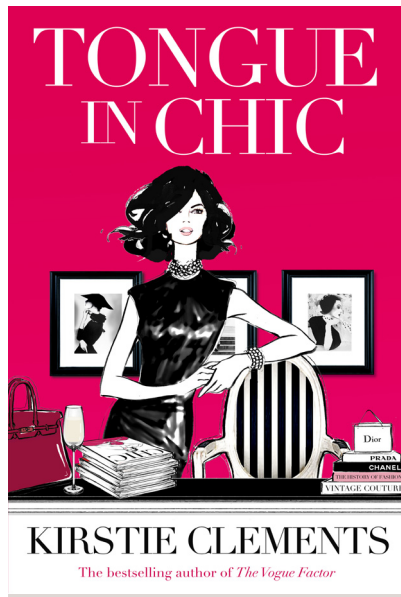

She has been a columnist with *The Sunday Telegraph* and a judge on *Australia's Next Top Model*.
